



# LIFEGUARDS

*These public beach accesses have parking and public restroom facilities.  
Lifeguards are stationed at the below locations mid-March - September.*



## Inlet Beach Access

located ¾ mile east of the intersection of Hwy 98 and Scenic 30A, turn south at Orange Street



## Santa Clara Access

located ½ mile east of intersection CR 395 and Scenic 30A, turn south at Bramble Grove Road



## Gulfview Heights Access

located 3 miles east of intersection CR 393 and Scenic 30A, turn south at Gulfview Heights Street



## Ed Walline Access

located at the intersection of CR 393 and Scenic 30A



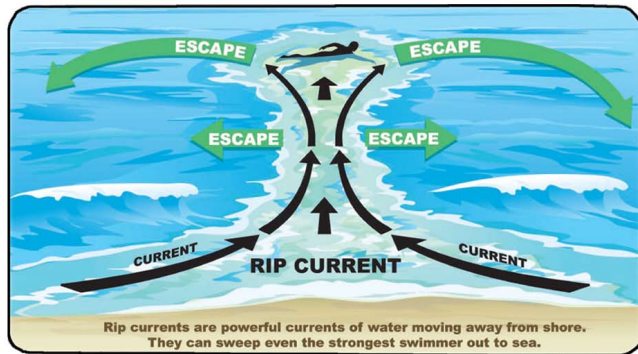
## Dune Allen Access

located west of intersection CR 393 and Scenic 30A, south of Scenic 30A across from Oyster Lake



## Miramar Beach Access

located off Scenic Gulf Drive, 2 miles west of intersection Hwy 98 and Scenic Gulf Drive



## *Beach Safety Tips:*

Don't dive in  
(2/3 of all catastrophic neck/  
head/spinal injuries happen  
in open water)

Know before you go...Pay  
close attention to the flag  
warning system

Knee deep is too deep on  
red flag days

The water is closed  
on double red flag days

Be cautious and  
swim close to shore. Always  
exercise caution when  
entering the gulf.
