It will prompt you to download ZOOM onto your computer if you do not already have it installed. I recommend that you download it before the meeting has started.

- After ZOOM is installed, the application will open, and a window will popup that reads “Enter your email and name”. Enter this information and click Join Webinar.
- To raise your hand to speak, click on ‘raise hand’ on the bottom of the ZOOM screen (you may have to move your mouse for the option to appear) and the host will see that you have raised your hand.
- When the host signals to unmute your line, then a popup will say “The host would like you to unmute your microphone.” You will need to click Unmute Now. You can then begin to talk.
